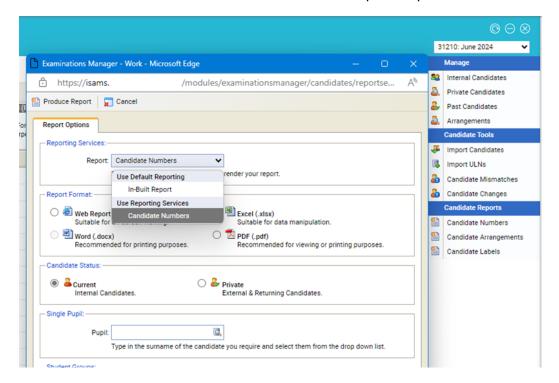
iSAMS Exports for import into SchoolWorkSpace Exams Assist

Candidate Numbers and Candidate Arrangements

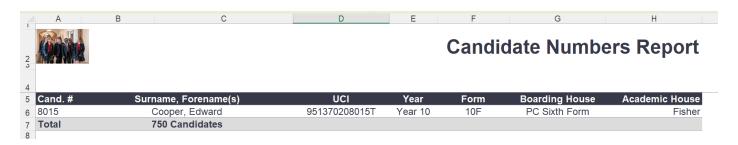
These 2 reports work together to provide candidate numbers and UCI for the students, as well as the Access arrangements from iSAMS data that does not come in from Wonde or Xporter but is needed for exams.

In iSAMS

Open Exams Manager and then go to the Candidates tab. From the wizard bar on the right-hand side, select 'Candidate Numbers' from the Candidate Reports Options

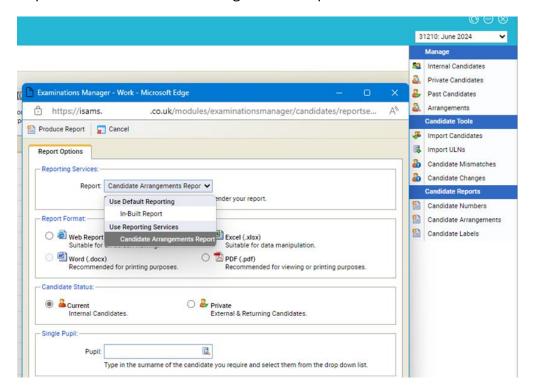


Select Candidate Numbers under 'Use Reporting Services', Report Format = Excel, Candidate Status = Current or Private (as applicable), and select student groups if applicable.

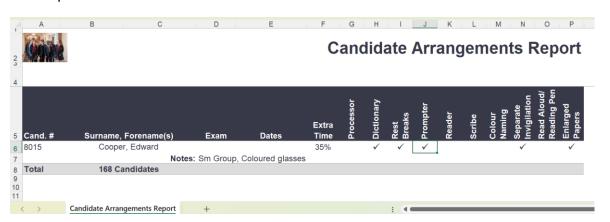


This produces an Excel that looks like this – Year and Forms and candidate name are used to match the students so we can set the Cand # and UCI.

Repeat for the 'Candidate Arrangements' Report.



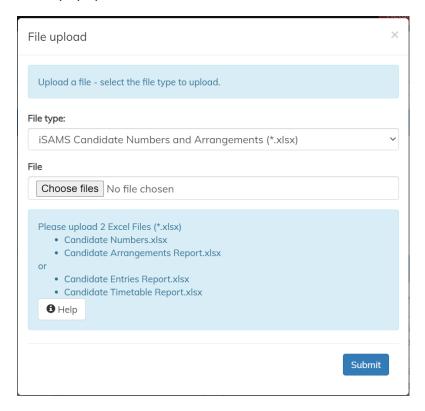
Which produces an Excel file that looks like:



In Exams Assist

From the Actions button on the Exams Assist Overview screen select "Upload iSAMS xlsx files"

In the popup



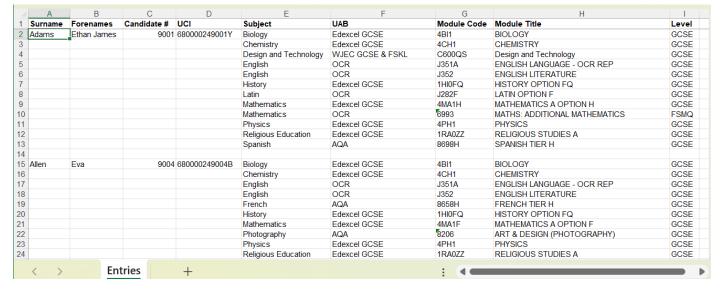
Click Choose files and select the 2 Excel files exported from iSAMS, and then Submit.

Candidate Entries and Timetable

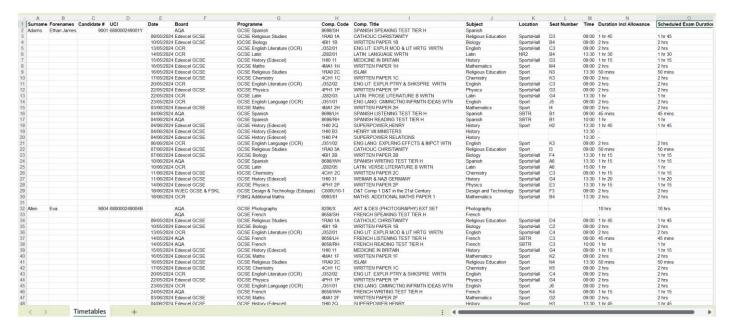
In addition to the Candidate Numbers and Candidate Arrangements Report we can import the Entries and Timetable. These 2 excel work together to provide the details required for Exams Assist.

In iSAMS

Create the Candidate Entries Report – which looks like:



And the Candidate Timetable report - which looks like:



Together these 2 Excel reports detail who is doing what and when and optionally where.

In Exams Assist

Ensure you have a season created and with the correct dates to cover the exams. E.g. "November 2024 Mocks" 01/11/2024 to 30/11/2024

Ensure this is the current season and from the Actions menu on the overview tab "Import iSAMS xlsx files" – select the 2 files you have just created from iSAMS.
